Kingwood Center invites you to be part of a special tour to experience the world famous Philadelphia International Flower Show, Longwood Gardens, and Winterthur Museum & Gardens. Bill Collins, Kingwood's Head Gardener, will lead this unique and educational tour from March 5 through 8, 2012.

Our trip will highlight the spectacular Philadelphia International Flower Show, the largest indoor flower show in the world. It is held in the Philadelphia Convention Center in the heart of historic Philadelphia, and close to many of the museums. The Philadelphia Horticulture Society sponsors the show which includes ten acres of lush gardens, horticultural specimens, floral designs, room and table settings, displays by plant societies, lectures & demonstrations, and a wonderful sales area. This years theme is **"Hawaii: Islands of Aloha."** Native and tropical plants will rise in a living wall amid cascades of orchids and thundering waterfalls. Hula dancers, torch-twirlers, and 3-D images of crashing waves and rumbling volcanos will honor Pele, the Goddess of Fire.

Wednesday morning we will visit Longwood Gardens, the world's premier horticultural display garden and former estate of Pierre S. du Pont. The gardens and five acre conservatory are exquisite and one of the finest gardens in the world. The highlight of the tour will be the "Orchid Extravaganza" in the conservatory.

Thousands of orchid blooms will cascade down walls, spill from containers, and adorn planting beds throughout the sixteen spectacular gardens in full, fragrant bloom. Weather permitting, we will also tour the grounds. There will also be time to shop in their gift and plant shops.

Wednesday afternoon we will visit Winterthur Museum and Gardens, the former estate of Henry F. du Pont. Winterthur is known for its magnificent collections of American furniture and decorative arts. Our visit will include a tram tour of the grounds, an introductory tour of parts of the mansion, and time in the special galleries and exhibitions in the new wing.

Lunch will be in their restaurant prior to the tour. There will also be time to spend in the two gift shops and tour the grounds (weather permitting).

On Thursday we will begin our trip back to Mansfield with an estimated arrival time around 6:30 p.m.

ITINERARY

Monday, March 5

Depart Mansfield for Philadelphia by private motor coach with several rest stops and a lunch stop. Fruit and cookies will be available during the trip. After settling in at the hotel, dinner will be served in the historic Concordville Inn. D

Tuesday, March 6

We will spend the entire day at the spectacular Philadelphia Flower Show. A bus will return to the hotel at 4:30 p.m. and another at 8:30 p.m. An optional tour of the historic area, or other museums may be done on your own. B

Wednesday, March 7

Longwood Gardens is our morning destination, where we will tour the grounds (weather permitting) and the five acre conservatory. We will then travel a short distance to Winterthur Museum and Gardens where we will have lunch followed by a one hour introductory tour of the period rooms in the mansion. B,L

Thursday, March 8

The tour leaves the hotel for our return to Mansfield. Several stops will be made during the bus trip home. B

Payment in full is due by February 1, 2012. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required upon registration.

Transportation- will be by private motor coach to, from and in Philadelphia. The motor coach is equipped with heat and air conditioning, toilet facilities. Smoking is not permitted on the motor coach.

Accommodations - We will be staying at the Concordville Hotel and Conference Center. The Concordville Inn is located adjacent to the hotel for your dining needs. A hot continental breakfast will be served each morning in the hotel. Guests can take advantage of the hotels fitness center and indoor swimming pool. Baggage will be handled by the hotel. Visible name tags should be placed on all bags. A single supplement will be an additional \$165. We will try to place people together if requested. Smoking will not be permitted during meals or other scheduled *tours*. *Most tours involve extensive walking.*

Cost Includes: Motor coach transportation, double occupancy at the Concordville Hotel and Conference Center, meals designated in the itinerary, all entrance fees, and services of Kingwood tour leader.

Cost does not include: Meals not specified and all items of a personal nature. Gratuity for motor coach driver is optional. **B - Breakfast, L - Lunch, D - Dinner**
